Born Sept. 22, 1926 in Winamac, he was the son of Earl D. and Loa Borrks Roudebush. On May 29, 1965, in Winamac, he was married to Clara Earwood, who survives.

Mr. Roudebush was a veteran of the U. S. Army, having served during World War II.

He currently was the owner of the Roudebush Company, Pulaski and the Moss Creek Country Club in Winamac.

He was formerly was the manager and part owner of Fun-Craft Ski Company and the owner of the Chuck Wagon Drive-in and Brooks Dry Cleaning, all of Winamac. He also was the owner of the Olympic Manufacturing Company, Adamsville, Tenn.

He was a member of the First Christian Church,, where he served several years on the church board and was a past president of the board.

He was past president of the Winamac Club, Arrowhead Past Lt. Governor of the Kiwanis and received many honors for Indiana District and Kiwanis International. He was distinguished Lt. Governor during his term and had 36 years of prefect attendance prior to his illness.

He was board member of the Pulaski County Chamber of Commerce and received the Chamber's Halleck Award for community service in 1997.

Mr. Roudebush, along with Donald Galbreath, started the building trades program locally to help young people to have a special trade after graduating from high school. He was a part president of the El-Tip-Wa Building Trades Board and was member of the board for many years.

He started the first water ski show at Indiana Beach Amusement Park in Monticello, and furnished the show with water skis for many years. He was the inventor of the water ski binder used by many skiers today.

He made one of the first skate boards and also invented the Flex-A-Board, a form of water ski. All were manufactured by the Fun-Craft Ski Company in Winamac.

When the annual Fourth of July fireworks display was in jeopardy, Mr. Roudebush promoted a way for them to continue locally.

He was a former employee of Donald Galbreath and Galbreath Incorporated.

He was also a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1728 in Winamac.
